1.1 **THE ORGANIZER IS:** Sailing Foundation Sailportal.pl, regattas have the character of an amateur sailing event

1.2 YACHT CLASSES & GROUPS & THE MAXIMUM NUMBER OF YACHTS

The organizer limits the number of yachts taking part in the long race to max. 25 items. The organizer may decide to increase or decrease this number

Groups will rise if at least 3 yachts will enlist, in Class Mini 650 2 yachts

Each Participant can apply simultaneously to several groups simultaneously: ORC, KWR, OPEN, Mini 650 - all starts will be shared

- A. CLASS ORC
- B. CLASS KWR
- C. CLASS Mini 650
- D. CLASS Open I - up 30 feet, 9,12m
- E. CLASS Open II – <= 30 feet, 9,12m

1.4 APPLICATIONS

A. Publication of documents and start of applications will take place 01.03.2019 on website www.regaty-poloneza.pl

B. Entry to the start list occurs After reading the Notice, applicable rules, regulations and accepting them:

- After sending completed application (without signature – only via e-mail bluefin@interia.pl in original WORD – NO SKAN, NO PRINT, NO PDF, !!!!!)
- After transferring reservation fee or confirmation of transfer in form of Donation to statutory activities of foundation Sailportal.pl
- After sending photographs of crew and yacht

C. Organizer does not is not responsible for costs caused by not accepting yacht registration

D. At 00:00 in day 1st August 2018 Organizer will download from website www.orc.org ORC International and ORC Club Certifications of all registered yachts. ORC Certificates can not be changed after that time without permission of Judges Committee and Organizer. This regulation changes PRZ 78.2.

E. Organizer has right to accept delayed yacht application to long race after 1st August (only the long race Polonez Cup),

F. Each of participants in case of resignation has a duty to immediately inform the Organizer about this fact.

G. Entries for short and medium races are held until the day of the race

1.5 REGISTRATION FEE

A. Registration fee has a nature of Donation to statutory activities of foundation Sailportal.pl (we do not issue VAT invoice)

B. The amount of registration fee is decided by date of receiving complete set of documents: correctly fulfilled application, photographs showing crew and yacht, confirmation of transfer or date of income on Foundation's account.

C. Registration fee not refundable in case of resignation from participation

2. RULES

- 2.1 Races will be conducted according identical to the regulations in Racing Sailing Rules
- 2.2 Following regulation identical are applicable: IMS Rule; ORC Rating Systems Rule; World Sailing (ISAF) Offshore Special Regulations, KWR Rule
- 2.3 OSR Categories for individual races (yachts must comply requirements for each category) and Safety Equipments: Short races at Pyromagic 2018 on Odra river in Szczecin and Medium Races „Swinoujscie Cup” will be conducted by category 4 OSR, Long race „Polonez Cup” will be conducted by category 3 OSR without liferafts
OSR Point 3.04.2 – According to interpretation of Appeal Marine Authorities in Gdynia yachts with design category C are allowed to participate in the long race
OSR Point 3.14 - Pulpits, Stanchions, Lifelines: yachts smaller than 8,5m length are exempted from keeping sizes of pulpits, stanchions and lifelines, no less than 30 cm – however they remain mandatory, yachts in category 3 OSR are exempted from obligatory possession of steel stormbelts. Ropes made of Dynemaa material with a minimum diameter of 6 mm are acceptable
OSR Point 3.23 – Bilge Pumps and Buckets: yachts smaller than 8,5m length are exempted from possessing fixed Bilge pump. Instead yacht has to possess bailer i 2 buckets min. 9l
OSR Point 3.27 – Navigational light: all yachts are exempted form carrying double navigational lights with independent power, as spare navigational light can be used any portable white or tricolor light source with illumination angle 360 degree or exceptionally a flashlight
OSR Point 3.29 – Communication equipment: yachts smaller than 8,5m length are exempted from possessing fixed DSC transceiver with antenna on mast. Instead yacht has to carry hand held UKF transceiver + according to requirements one spare watertight radio transceiver as backup
OSR Point 4.06 - Anchors: yachts smaller than 8,5m length are exempted from possessing a combination of chain and rope, anchors may have only ropes with sufficient strength
If the boats do not have a storm sail in accordance with section 4.25, yachts must have: - Mainsail (arrowhead) with the possibility of reefing - Additional sail front of reduced surface area in relation to the major headsail and or capable of reefing optimally robust (ORC groups in the sail must be measured and active Sails Inventory). Storm sails in accordance with section 4.25 does not have to be measured and are not reported to the Sails Inventory. We remind you that in accordance with ORC yachts in ORC groups may have in the course of the race, only one mainsail sail on board (not dot. Storm sail)
RYA Point 4.22 - yachts are released from having a signal pole with a weight and light attached to the lifebuoy

3 ADVERTISEMENT

- 3.1 Advertisement Code ISAF is valid. Participants and yachts may use advertisement without limits
- 3.2 Organizer requires that materials handed to participants for placement on yachts were place since moment of handing, to moment of leaving marina on completion of event, in the following way: starting number with advert, on both side, as close as possible to bow, on forward 20% of hull's length; or on deckhouse in visible place, organizer pennant with group flag has to be hanged on backstay for the entire duration of race
- 3.3 Advertisement materials and starting numbers from other races has to be removed from yachts
- 3.4 Any promotional actions are forbidden in the area of event without permission from Organizer

4 PERSONAL APPLICATIONS

- 4.1 Crew of every enlisted yacht participating in race Prestart Pyromagic 2019 in Szczecin on Odra river must personally report to Office of the Race in North East Marina Szczecin between 08:00 and 10:00 on Saturday, 10.08.2019
- 4.2 Crew of every enlisted yacht participating in race Swinoujscie Cup 2019 must personally report to Office of the Race in Marina OSIR Swinoujscie between 08:00, and 10:00 on Monday, 12.08.2019
- 4.3 Crew of every enlisted yacht participating in long race Polonez Cup must personally report to Office of the Race in Marina OSIR Swinoujscie between 16:00 and 19:00 on Monday, 12.08.2019
- 4.4 All crewmembers must be weighed in Office of the Race during personal application refer to point from 7.1 to 7.3 (only ORC – each participant will be weighed just once)
- 4.5 While applying to first chosen race one has to present following documents:
 - A. copy of measurement certificate for ORC or KWR. The day before the first race - after that time you can not change the ORC certificate
 - B. valid insurance of civil liability
 - C. signed form of accepting responsibility, statement and reading of event documents
- 4.6 Measurement protest submitted by crews will be received during personal applications and during skipper briefing before individual races, data from certificates will be available on starting lists and on website of ORC Office
- 4.7 Starting lists will be blocked on 1th August 2018, after this time it will not be possible to make any changes (only long race)

5 ORC YACHT MEASUREMENT & SAFETY MEASUREMENT ALL YACHT

Every yacht willing to start in chosen races must be available for measurement inspection in North East Marina in Szczecin, and in Marina OSIR Swinoujscie, before races during personal applications, as well as during races, especially before or after each race, with special attention paid to yachts leading in scoring. Inspection will as far as possible include checking freeboards

6 SAILING INSTRUCTION

Sailing instruction will be available to each participant after completion of application formalities during personal applications, and before all races

7 PENALTY SYSTEM RRS

Yacht which violates rules of second part of PRŻ (during race) shall accept penalty of 2 turns, while for violating (31 PRŻ – touching a sign – start only) shall accept penalty of 1 turn. Yacht shall accept penalty of turns as fast as possible. Turns shall be done in the same direction, each turn contains one tacking and one jibing. Yacht accepting point penalty (44.3 PRŻ) shall carry yellow flag, until the end of race and inform JC during finishing the race. Points in race for yacht accepting point penalty (degraded by 2 places vs. correctly achieved place). Yacht violating start sequence will receive 20% penalty but no more than DNS yacht

8 SCORING AND METHOD OF CONVERSION OF RESULTS

- 8.1 Race results for ORC classes will be established based on the corrected times: conversion method for each race, will be detailed in the Sailing Instruction Special Scoring Double Handed GPH
- 8.2 Results of race of OPEN, Mini 650 classes will be determined on basis of actual finishing time without correcting time
- 8.3 Results of all five race in ALL classes will emerge Single & Double Champion Sailportal.pl Sailing Foundation
- 8.4 System of small point is applicable according to PRŻ, Appendix A. Points achieved in long race will be multiplied by a factor of difficulty which is equal 2
- 8.5 Race results will be valid, if at least on race will be finished
- 8.6 Results of any of the races will not be rejected
- 8.7 Race results for KWR classes will be established based on the corrected times x time

9 JUDGES COMMITTEE AND ROUTES

- 9.1 Races will be supervised by Judges Committee appointed by the Organizer, without right to appeal, according to PRŻ 70.5. This regulation changes PRŻ, Appendix N. 14 Race area, decisions Judges Committee are definitive
- 9.2 Routes of individual races will be exactly described in Sailing Instruction:
 - A. Short races Prestart Pyromagic in Szczecin will be conducted on Odra river on inshore sea waters along Wyspa Grodzka island, route will be permanent, and point of sail will be dependent on its direction, each race shall last about 30 minutes
 - B. Medium races on Pomeranian Bay in Swinoujscie will be conducted on west side of approach fairway to port. Route will be set dependently on wind direction – Races up- down-wind will be conducted in vicinity of Port Swinoujscie, each race shall last about 60 minutes
 - C. Long race Non Stop – will be conducted on route Swinoujscie – Christianso – Swinoujscie, start and finish will have place on Pomeranian Bay in vicinity Port Swinoujscie

10 YACHT BERTH PLACES

- 10.1 Free of charge berth places will be available in North East Marina in Szczecin since Friday 09.08.2019 til 11.08.2019 (during fireworks show, yachts can remain in marina on skipper's sole responsibility)
- 10.2 Free of charge berth places will be available in Marina OSIR Swinoujscie since 12.08.2019 till 18.08.2019
- 10.3 Maps of berth places will be available on website www.regaty-poloneza.pl, and send to participants via e-mail

11 MEDIA RIGHT

participants give right to Organizer and declare permission to photograph and film people and yachts, publication of these materials for publishing and advertising purposes, this is confirmed in signed statement

12 COMMUNICATION

- 12.1 Excluding communications with Judges Committee, yacht during race can not transmit or receive information, which are not openly available to all participants
- 12.2 Communication during event for participants is Channel 77 UKF it is working channel (continuous listening on Channel 16 is highly recommended)
- 12.3 All communicates will be available on noticeboards in places of event organization

13 CUPS, MEDALS, STATUETTES, OTHER PRIZES

- 13.1 Historical Polonez Cup is acquired by participant, who will cover the race route in shortest corrected time in Single ORC class
- 13.2 Cups Champions of Poland sponsored by Sailportal Sailing Foundation are acquired by: Winner of all class (sum of 5 races)
- 13.3 Transitive Cups of Kuba Jaworski and Jerzy Siudy are acquired by skippers of yachts, which will as first in elapsed time cross the finish line (independently from the group)
- 13.4 Statuettes „Pyromagic Szczecin” made to special order are received by every yacht, which will take part in Prestart Pyromagic Szczecin – they are going to be given on Main Stage of Pyromagic Festival in Szczecin 10.08.2019
- 13.5 Statuettes „Swinoujscie Cup” m – they are going to be given on Long Race Skipper Briefing 12.08.2019
- 13.6 Hand-made statuettes for entire race made to special order with a summary long race and all races for each yacht, are received by skippers of all yachts participating
- 13.7 Material prizes from partners i sponsors, are going to be draw among present participants on Ending ceremony
- 13.7 All awards, cups and statuettes will be given to participants present during Ending ceremony, which will take place on 18.08.2019 in Swinoujscie. Unclaimed statuettes during Ending ceremony can be collected in person only in Szczecin from the Organizer, or during other trade fairs where the Organizer will display. Due to material which statuettes are made from, we do not send them via post or courier

14 LIMITATION OF RESPONSIBILITY AND SAFETY

- 14.1 All participants are taking part in races on their own at their own risk and on their own responsibility (signed statement)
- 14.2 The attention of participants is drawn rule 4 of part 1 ISAF RRS – Fundamental laws: Each Person in charge is individually solely responsible for decision to participate in race or continue racing, is personally responsible for his voyage, meeting the requirements of minimum yacht equipment, crew's entitlements, compliance with safety requirements according to applicable regulations and rules of good marine practice.
- 14.3 Organizer, Partners, PSA, ORC and any other party associated with organization of races does not assume any responsibility for losses, damages, loss of health or inconvenience concerning persons or things, both on land and on water, as a consequence of participation in the event
- 14.4 Organizer and Judge Committee do not supply any physical and online assistance during long race. In case of failures, life threats: participants have duty to act according to internationally recognized standards of conduct in case of saving lives at sea and calling help.
- 14.5 Participant acknowledges that participation in the race long with the risk of delayed arrival of emergency aid
- 14.6 The participant is obliged to appoint his own team coastline providing a personalized online assistance on the basis of Tracking Satellite YB, should establish ways of contact and communication, and the moments when the team has the edge to start immediately the rescue procedures, the participant may also establish their own assistance on water
- 14.7 It is recalled that in accordance with RRS participant can not use external assistance during the race, nor use the information provided, which can not access the other participants. You can benefit from such assistance after discontinuation of the race

15 **INSURANCE** Each participating yacht has to possess liability insurance of yacht valid for the time of event. We recommend the services of Proffman Insurance Broker.

16 **CHANGES IN CONTENT OF EVENT DOCUMENTS** - Content of Rules, Notice, Sailing Instruction and participant statement, deadlines may change
